

Hobart City and Surroundings

Our local tour guide will pick you up from your hotel. Firstly, we will start with the tour of the capital city of Tasmania – Hobart, which includes the birthplace of Hobart - Battery Point, Salamanca Place, the oldest brewery in Australia and Mt Wellington, at the top of which people will experience the spectacular views of Hobart and surrounds. We will also explore historical Richmond, which tells the story of an early Australian colonial village. Richmond has more than 50 Georgian buildings, of which the town's most photographed landmark is the Richmond Bridge. Built by convicts in the 1820s, it's the oldest bridge in Australia and offers a perfect picnic spot on the grassy banks of the Coal River. The last stop is Zoodoo, which is one of the Tasmania's largest where you can come face-to-face with exotic, native and agricultural animals


